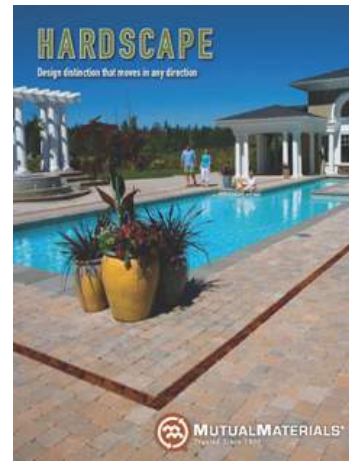
The branch will open to the public April 1 and operate Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
